Common indications for ablation:

- Typical atrial flutter (success rate 95-98%)
- Atrial fibrillation (LA should be < 6cm):
 - Symptomatic AF if one anti-arrhythmic failed.
 - Combination of AF and a cardiomyopathy.

Common indications for biventricular pacing (LV lead addition to an ICD or pacemaker):

- Cardiomyopathy (ischemic and nonischemic) with QRS > 120-130ms (or predominant ventricular pacing with wide QRS) in combination with class II-IV CHF despite optimal beta-blocker/ACE inhibitor therapy.

Common indications for ICD implantation:

- Cardiomyopathy (ischemic and nonischemic) with EF \leq 35% and reasonable life quality and expectancy.

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
