Dr. Mark Lebenthal, F.A.C.C., F.A.C.P joined Cardiology Associates of Somerset County in 1982 and is currently the practice's senior member. In more than two decades with the group, he has witnessed many changes, seeing growth from a two to seven physician group and a transformation from an Internal Medicine/Cardiology practice to a pure subspecialty of Cardiovascular Disease.

Dr. Lebenthal is an Attending Physician at Somerset Medical Center, Somerville, NJ and Robert Wood Johnson University Hospital, New Brunswick, NJ. He is a Fellow of the American College of Cardiology and the American College of Physicians. He is a member of the Medical Society of New Jersey, American Medical Association and the American Heart Association, Somerville Chapter.

Dr. Lebenthal has a long-standing association with Somerset Medical Center and has been on staff as an Attending Physician since 1982. During this period he has held many positions, such as: Department Director of Medicine, Chief of Cardiology, Director of the Cardiac Rehabilitation Center, as well as, the Medical Executive Committee. He has served as chairperson of several committees at Somerset Medical Center that include; the Patient Care Committee, the Medical Equipment Committee and Medical Education Committee.

From 1983 to 1986 directed the American Heart Associations' "Caring Hearts Lecture Series", where he served as President of the Somerville Chapter of the American Heart Association starting in 1988 thru 1989. At the state level, Dr. Lebenthal was appointed to the C.H.A.P., the Cardiac Health Advisory Panel, where he was instrumental in bringing Cardiac Catheterization for low risk patients throughout many New Jersey Hospitals.

Dr. Lebenthal is presently a teacher for the Family Practice Residency Program at Somerset Medical Center. He was awarded Somerset Medical Center's Teaching Aware in Clinical Medicine in 1984. He was awarded the American Medical Associations' Physician recognition Award as well. His clinical research has been published in the American Heart Journal and the Journal of Coronary Artery Disease.

Dr. Lebenthal completed his undergraduate studies at Brooklyn College, Brooklyn, NY. He then earned his Medical Degree at Autonomous University of Guadalajara in Guadalajara, Mexico. He performed his 5th Pathway program at Queens General Hospital, Queens, NY.

He completed his Internship and Medical Residency at NJ College of Medicine, Newark, NJ. He then went on to complete his fellowship in Cardiovascular Disease at Jefferson University, Philadelphia, PA.
